

# **GLENBURN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS Meeting– August 18, 2021**

Supervisor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM with the pledge to the flag.

Requested a moment of silence for three Abington residents who recently passed away, two of whom who resided in Glenburn Township: Hunter James and Sara Hutchinson. Tim Millett of Waverly Twp also passed away and was known by many in our Township.

## **Public Comment Period**

Geoffrey MacGregor of Church Hill Road expressed concern to the Board about the deteriorating condition of Church Hill Rd. Mr. MacGregor also acknowledged the great work that Mark Hopkins does throughout the year to make it passable. Supervisor Wicks said that Church Hill is on the list of roads we hope to fix next year.

Anthony Fiero requested information on getting a lot combination for his property. Mr. Fiero was advised to seek input and review from the Planning Commission. Secretary Menendez offered to assist.

Edwin Tyler requested permission to get a plaque to honor his Great Grandfather for the area called CAPTAIN WHITE HILL, as a point in Glenburn Township. Served during the Civil War. Supervisors approved the request for a plaque to be placed in the Township Building.
