

MINUTES FOR GLENBURN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING

June 15 2022

Supervisor Davis called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM with the pledge to the flag.

Minutes

Unfinished Business

Road Bid Update - Supervisor Wicks said the bid package was reviewed by South Abington and awarded to Wayco. The projects previously identified by Glenburn are still ok for the repairs and Zack was sending a letter of intent. PennDOT will be coming in to review and approve the Township's use of Liquid Fuels.

New Business

Preliminary Police Regionalization Report /Assessment – Supervisor Keisling reported that the state consultant presented a report to the regionalization committee. There were many questions and some concerns raised by townships who would see a drastic increase in spending for police coverage. As proposed in the preliminary report, the cost for Glenburn would increase by more than \$160,000 to \$231,000. Glenburn will remain engaged in the next few meetings but Supervisor Keisling is discouraged by the potential financial impact this would be for the Township.

Supervisor Wicks motioned to adjourn at **7:08 PM.** and seconded by Supervisor Keisling. All in Favor.
